Alumni will be encouraged to reconnect with their chapters – first by viewing their chapter's online directory and secondly by becoming active as a speaker or supporter of their chapter. • Through HKN's affiliation with IEC, executives and professionals in the technology field are regularly reminded that IEC administers HKN and are asked to support the organization both monetarily and as speakers. • A contribution campaign is conducted annually to solicit funding for HKN initiatives such as funding support for Regional Student Conferences.
